

Clothing Policy for Tamarack Center

1. Residents are allowed their own personal clothing. Tamarack does not supply hospital gowns or pajamas.
2. Clothing items may not exceed the allowable range on the clothing inventory.
3. Clothing which depicts violence, gang alliance or culture, satanic messages/propaganda, alcohol/drug use will not be permitted.
4. Proper undergarments are required.
5. No clothing may be worn if it exposes breasts, buttocks, abdomen, or genitalia.
6. Feet must be covered when in the milieu. Shoes and slippers are required.
7. Night clothes are required for both sexes that cover top and bottom.
8. Clothing must be appropriate for weather condition.
9. Spandex clothing must be individually approved to be worn in the milieu and generally only for recreational programs and times designated for physical exercise.
10. Hats and coats may not be worn on the milieu except for designated times which relate to program status and personal hygiene.
11. Clothing must be changed daily.
12. Residents are assigned two laundry times per week. Residents are responsible for completing their laundry on time.
